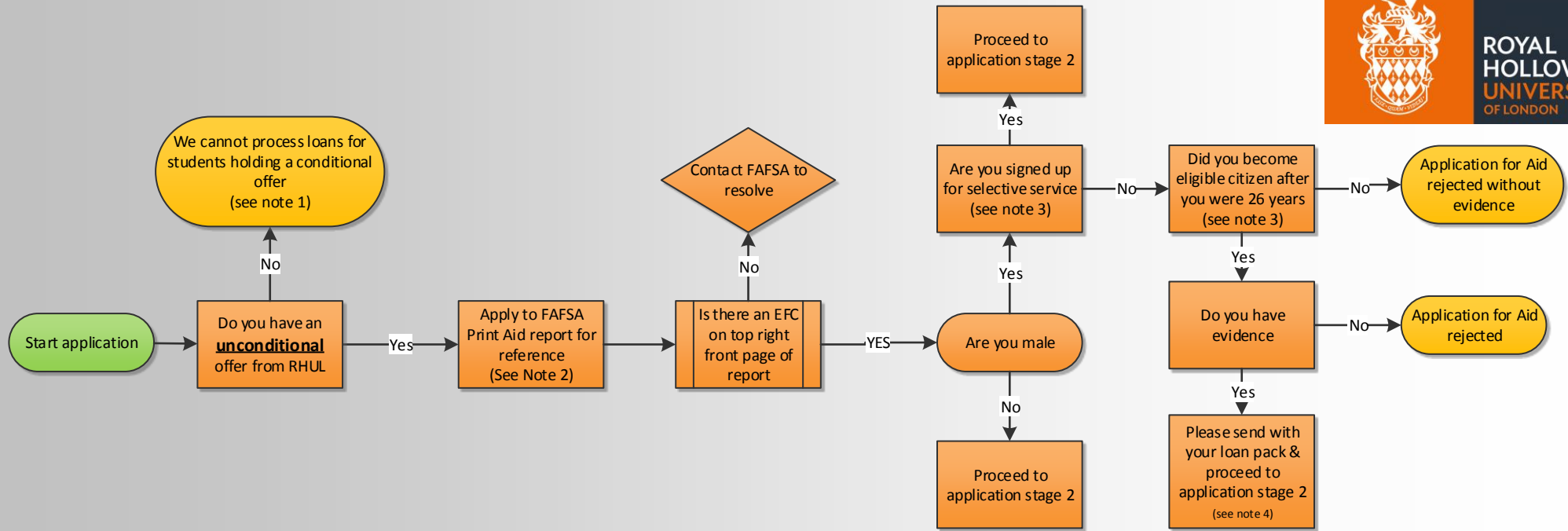


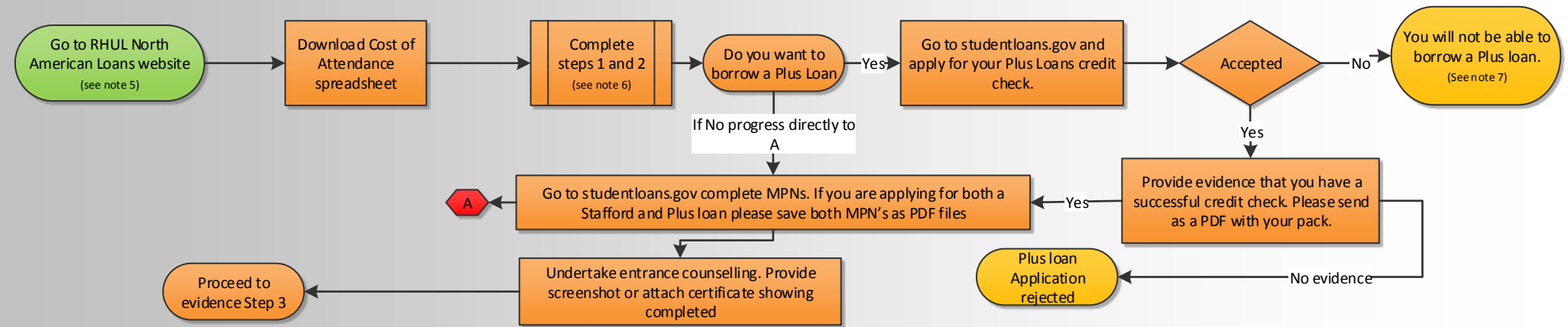
Application for Federal Direct Loans



Step 1: Eligibility

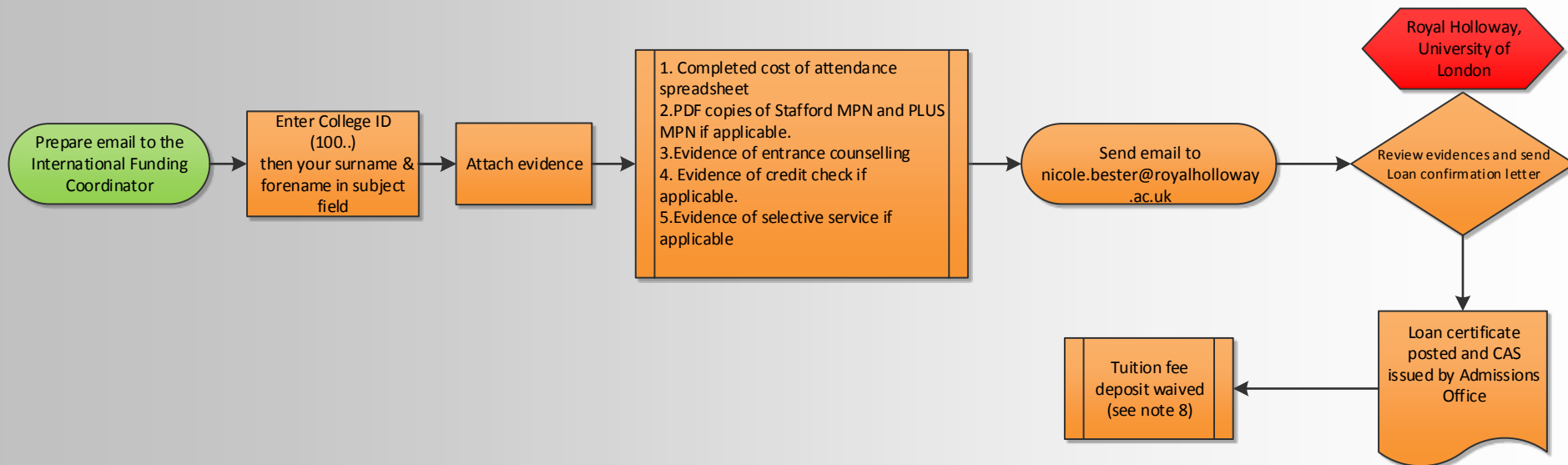

Step 3: Evidence



Note 1: Only students who hold an unconditional offer can apply for a loan, students holding a conditional offer can complete the application to find out how much they can borrow, but no loans or CAS number will be issued until an unconditional offer is confirmed. Students should not complete a credit check unless they hold an unconditional offer, credit checks are only valid for 180 days and multiple credit check will leave a negative mark on your credit score.

Note 3: Selective Service is a United States law where all male U.S. citizens are required to register with Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday. In addition, foreign males between the ages of 18 and 25 living in the United States must register.

This includes permanent residents (holders of Green Cards), refugees, asylees, dual citizens, and illegal aliens.

Foreign males in the United States as lawful non-immigrants (international students, visitors, diplomats, etc.) are not required to register. If you became a citizen or US permanent resident after the age of 26 you are not required to register however we need to have documentation that you became a citizen after the age of 26.

Notes

The following proof of exemption would be required:

- Green card, front and back
- Visas beginning from the time you initially entered the United States
- Email explanation of your status from the time you entered the United States until receiving your permanent residency (green card)
- Status Information Letter from Selective Service System (SIL). Although the SSS website states that information letters are not needed for a Non-U.S. male on a valid non-immigrant visa, it is best to apply for this letter.

The former three documents are sent over to and reviewed by the International Funding Coordinator. If they determine that they need the additional document of the Status Information Letter, then you will have to apply at that time. Processing of this letter by the SSS could take up to 90 days.

Note 6: The form will advise maximum loans that you can borrow, you must enter your tuition fees, any scholarships or grants (EFA) and your EFC on this spreadsheet. From the eligible loan amounts indicated please enter how much you wish to borrow. Save this spreadsheet as you will use this again.

Note 7: You can try again with an endorser.

Note 8: You will need to have taken out enough loans to fully cover your tuition fees in order to waive the tuition fee deposit.
